### **DENNIS EAGLE'S SCOTTISH SUCCESS**

Leading refuse collection vehicle manufacturer Dennis Eagle has enjoyed recent success in Scotland, with two new orders from Inverclyde Council and Dundee City Council.

Inverclyde Council has taken delivery of eight new RCVs, following a 16 year history of working with Dennis Eagle. The vehicles comprise 6x4 Elite 2 W chassis with Olympus 21W bodies and will be servicing 39,500 households throughout Inverclyde.

Transport officer for Inverclyde, John McWilliams, commented: "We have worked with Dennis Eagle for a number of years and we have found that their vehicles suit our operations. The sales, after sales, warranty and service teams are always willing to help to ensure that any issues that arise are solved quickly."

Dundee City Council has three new trucks, taking the number of Dennis Eagle vehicles in its fleet to 33. The new additions are a 6x2 Elite 2 W Mid Lift with Olympus 19W body and two 6x2 Elite 2 W Mid Steer with Olympus 21W bodies. They were chosen partly due to their low entry cab, making entering and exiting easier for the crews onboard. The different vehicles are also able to cope with the varieties of refuse collection, including black bag, wheelie bin waste and paladin collection.

Stewart Dodd, team leader for the waste management department for Dundee City council comments: "We have been working with Dennis Eagle for over 12 years as it offers a one stop shop for all of our requirements. The vehicles are reliable, well built and fit for purpose and buying the complete package from one company means that we can be sure that everything works properly."

Dennis Eagle will be attending the APSE show in May, a fleet, waste and grounds conference held in Aviemore, Scotland. The three day event is a chance for the company to showcase its trucks to the 32 local authorities from all over Scotland who attend.



Norman Thoday, managing director of Dennis Eagle comments: “The APSE show is always a key date in our diary as it gives us the chance to meet various representatives from the councils in Scotland and demonstrate the high quality of Dennis Eagle’s vehicles.
